What we are looking for...

A staff member accompanies you through reflection and counseling. We are looking for a person that is open and communicative and is not afraid to get to know new people (kids and teens). We are looking for someone who shows initiative and motivation in the everyday life. We are looking for someone, who has good knowledge of German (Level A2 till B1). We are a christian association and living out the christian values. That's why we are looking for someone that is christian, who wants to talk with others about god, religion and good life. (because we also pray sometimes in the community). You are all of that? We would love to be your companion in this year.

We offer...

- a year full of experiences in the social work field (social work, weekly projects, little daycamps)
- Please choose between kindergarten (age 3 till 6 years), family center (age 0 till 10 years and parents), school club (age 10 till 16 years) and open youth work (age 8 till 27 years) ---
- innovative and independent working (also orientated on your gifts)
- working in a team of motivated young people
- participation in five seminars with volunteers from international YMCAs

What you could expect...
